March truly has filled our hearts with joy seeing all the faces we have missed over the months.





Alaska residents age 65 and older may qualify for a monthly payment from the Senior Benefits Program. Monthly payments are \$76, \$175, or \$250 depending on your annual income. Applications are available for mail out or pick up from the center.

Nikiski Senior Center Pantry

The NSC pantry is stocked and available to seniors 50 and older who live in the Nikiski Community. Recipients can come by Tuesdays or Thursdays from 9 am to 2 pm once every 14 days.

Meals on Wheels

We are now providing Meals on Wheels to our community in the age range of 18 and older receiving



Medicaid Waiver Services. This will allow us to care for our community members in need and seniors.



Marryann's Corner

Raisin Bran Muffins from Maryann's sister-in-law is one of her favorites.

- 5 Cups Flower
- 3 Cups Sugar
- 5 tsp Baking soda
- 11/2 tsp Salt

- 1 Quart Buttermilk
- 1 Cup Oil
- 4 Eggs, beaten
- Cinnamon Sugar
- 7 1/2 Cups Raisin Bran (15 oz box)

Blend flour, sugar, soda & salt in large mixing bowl. Stir in cereal. Add buttermilk, oil, & eggs; blend until ingredients are moistened. Do not stir batter again! For baking, fill lightly greased muffin pans 2/3 full. Sprinkle with cinnamon sugar. Bake at 400 degrees for 15 to 20 minutes. Mixture may be stored, covered, in a non-metal bowl in refrigerator for up to 6 weeks.
