Apple Sauce Donuts

- 4 Cups Bisquick
- 1 Cup Apple Sauce
- 1/4 Cup Brown Sugar
- 1 Egg
- 1 tsp. Vanilla

1. Heat (3 to 4 inches) oil in deep fryer or kettle 375 degrees.

2. Mix all ingredients until dough cleans side of bowl.

Gently smooth dough into a ball on lightly floured cloth covered board. Knead 8 to 10 times. Roll dough 1/2 inch thick. Cut with floured donut cutter (you can use a jar ring or anything to cut, use smaller to make donut holes.

1 1/4 tsp. Cinnamon

1/4 tsp. Nutmeg


3. Drop rings 3 at a time into hot oil.

4. Fry about 1 minute on each side or until golden brown, drain. If you like, shake warm doughnuts in powder or granulated sugar.
