Kelly's Corner

Sour Cream Banana Bread

1/2 cup sour cream

4 ripe bananas

1 cup sugar

3/4 cup softened butter

1 tsp vanilla extract

1 tsp banana extract

 $2 \frac{1}{4}$ cup flour

2 tsp salt

1 tsp baking soda

2 tsp cinnamon

1/2 cup chopped walnuts (optional)

Mix all ingredients together. Pour into greased loaf pans about 2/3 from top & bake at 325 degrees for about 40 minutes. Test with tooth pick. Let cool 20 minutes and then gently take bread out of loaf pan and let cool on parchment paper.
