### **DIRECTOR'S MESSAGE**

On behalf of the entire Nikiski Senior Center staff, I want to wish you and your family a happy and healthy new year. The New Year always brings with it feelings of renewal and hope. We are looking forward to continuing all the great work that is happening at our center.

Additional Senior Housing continues to be my main focus. The projected cost for this project is 1.6 million. We broke ground this summer and were able to clear the lot for construction, and order the septic tank. This was possible with grant funding from the Alaska Community Foundation. I continue to seek out grant funding and encourage those that can, to donate toward this much needed cause. When I became the Executive Director in December of 2020, we had a housing waitlist of 19. That wait list continues to grow on a daily basis and now has a total of 43 seniors. When the Alaska Commission of Aging visited us in the summer of 2021, they identified senior housing to be vital amongst the senior population. The COVID pandemic has only increased this need, and more seniors are looking to move to rural areas due to the inflation of housing in city limits. If you or someone you know is able to donate to this worthy cause, please contact the center for information. We are a non-profit entity, donations made count as a tax deduction.

2023 is going to be another great year! We will continue to offer new an innovative activities and services, as well as, keep the ones that you most enjoy. It truly is my pleasure to serve the seniors and members of my community. I look forward to 2023 with all of you!



### **Article V-Board of Director Nominations & Elections**

### 5.05: Nomination

- a. A person may self-nominate provided they meet the qualifications in Article 5.04.
- b. In all elections, the privilege of nominating from the floor shall be allowed provided the nominee has given consent and meets qualifications for the position stated in Article 5.04.
- c. Candidates who accept nominations (30) days prior to the annual meeting will be featured in the monthly newsletter.

### 5.06: Elections

- a. Board of director elections shall be held in correspondence with the annual membership meeting, in accordance with election procedures. The board of directors shall be responsible for the development of election procedures.
- b. Election of the board of directors shall be by ballot. When there is only one nominee for a seat, a voice vote may suffice.
- c. Absentee ballots shall be allowed if in conformance with article IV.




