

#### DIRECTOR'S MESSAGE

February was another blessed month at the center. Sweetheart BINGO was a massive success with over 70 participants. Kenai Peninsula, Family Caregivers Group, joined us for lunch with a brief presentation of their services and fantastic door prizes. Our new board members have taken their seats and look forward to their training this month. The Nikiski Middle High School Snack Shack continues to be a great collaboration bringing in funds to support student sports programs and our senior housing expansion. Our sewing group has made tremendous progress on our quilts for our Quilt BINGO Fundraiser coming in August. Many have enjoyed the fun crafts Laurajean teaches on Wednesdays. I could go on and on! Please come to the center and enjoy our great activities and services.

I continue to apply for grant funding to complete our Senior Housing Expansion. Most of our events and fundraisers go toward this project. Nikiski Senior Center received substantial property gifted to us by the Evenson Family. It is our goal to continue preparations for the property and build. To date, we have received over \$190,000 in funding. We used the monies to finalize our housing plans as well as, in the fall of 2022, cleared acreage for construction, overburden removed, 60-10yd loads of gravel delivered, and the septic was purchased. There is still more dirt work, including installing the septic system, drilling the water well, installing the line from the water well, excavating the building area, bringing the lot to grade, and moving the 60 loads of gravel to the construction area. Additional gravel/fill will is needed to get the lot to grade.

It has been two years since the Alaska Commission of Aging visited our center and stated that housing is the top need among the senior population in Alaska. Since 2020 our housing waitlist has grown from 19 to 49. Nikiski's last registered population was 4,579, with over 792 of those aged 65+. We serve adults 55 and older, increasing our responsibility to serve by 512 residents. Our current membership count is 448, and continues to grow.



creamy champagne chicken for 2

Laurajean Recipe

#### Ingredients:

- 1 tablespoon olive oil
- · 2 skinless and boneless chicken breast fillets
- · salt, to taste
- 14 ounces sliced mushrooms
- · 2 teaspoons butter
- 4 green onions (finely chopped)
- 1/2 cup champagne (or sparkling white wine)
- 2/3 cup heavy cream
- · fresh chopped parsley, to garnish

## Heat olive oil in skillet over medium heat. Season each chicken breast with a pinch of salt. Sear on both sides, for about 3 to 5 minutes each (depending on thickness), until golden. Transfer chicken to plate.

- Fry mushrooms in butter until begin to soften. Transfer to plate, topping chicken. Cover and keep warm.
- Add onions to pan and cook for 4 minutes. Pour in the champagne, stir well, while scrapping any food bits
  from the bottom of the pan for added flavor. Season with salt and pepper, then allow to simmer for about
  10 minutes.
- Pour cream into the center of pan and simmer for 2 to 3 minutes. Add chicken and mushrooms to the sauce along with any cooking juices, Coat in the creamy sauce. Sprinkle with parsley and enjoy.
