

Laurajean remembers Bob on St. Patrick's Day



Ingredients:

- 1 pound carrots, peeled
- · 2 teaspoons Dijon mustard
- · 1 tablespoon freshly squeezed lemon juice, from one lemon
- 11/2 tablespoons vegtable oil
- 11/2 tablespoons extra virgin olive oil
- 1-2 teaspoons honey (to taste)
- Heaping 1/4 teaspoon salt
- 1/4 teaspoon freshly ground black pepper (to taste)
- · 2 tablespoons chopped fresh parsley
- · 2 finely sliced scallions (or 1 tablespoon finely chopped shallots)
- 1 cup raisins

Instructions:

- Shred the carrots in a food processor. Set aside.
- In a sald bowl, combine the dijon mustard, lemon juice, honey, vefetable oil, olive oil, salt and pepper. Add the carrots, fresh parsley and scallions (or shallots) and toss well. Taste and adjust seasoning if neaded. Cover and refrigerate until ready to serve.

Notes: depending on the sweetness of the carrots, you may want to add more or less honey. Also if you make this salad ahead of time, be sure to check the sasoning again before serving as the flavors tend to mellow.
