

#### Access Alaska has a new resource!


- Are you a senior or someone with a disability who continues to feel socially isolated after the Covid-19 pandemic?



#### Ingredients:

- 1 tablespoon salt
- 1 tablespoon rosemary leaves
- 2 packages active dry yeast
- about 7 cups of all-purpose flour
- 21/2 cups water
- · I tablespoon butter or margarine, softened
- legg, slightly beaten
   Instructions:
- In a large bowl, combine salt, rosemary leaves, yeast and 2
   1/2 cups flour. In 2-quart saucepan over low heat, heat water and butter until very warm (120 to 130 degrees).
   (Butter does not need to melt)
- With mixer at medium speed, gradually beat liquid into dry ingredients. Beat 2 min, scraping bowl occasionally. Add 1 cup flour or enough to make a thick batter; beat 2 min at high speed, scraping bowl occasionally. With a spoon, stir in 3 1/2 cups of flour to make a soft, sticky dough.
- Place in greased bowl; cover with a towel. let the dough rise in a warm place, away from draft, until doubled, about 11/2 hours.
- Punch down dough and turn out onto well-floured surface.
  Knead until smooth and elastic, about 10 minutes. Divide
  dough into 6 equal pieces; roll each piece into an 18 inch
  rope, on one side of the cookie sheet braid 3 ropes. Repeat
  with remaining ropes. Cover with a towel; let rise in warm
  place until doubled, about 30 minutes.
- Preheat oven to 450 degrees. Brush tops of loaves with egg. Bake 30 minutes or until loaves sound hallow when tapped with fingers. Remove to racks to cool.
