

#### From the Kitchen of Zanetta Blueberry Crumb Bars

SERVES: PREP TIME: COOK TIME: COOL TIME:

15 30 MIN Ingredients

3 Cups All purpose flour 1/2 Cup granulated sugar 1/2 Cup packed brown sugar 1 teaspoon baking powder 1/4 teaspoon salt

1 teaspoon baking powder 4 1/4 teaspoon salt te 1 1/2 teaspoons vanilla extract

1 cup chilled butter cut into cubes

35-40 MIN 20-30 MIN

Filling:

1 Tablespoon cornstarch 1/2 cup granulated sugar

11/2 Tablespoon lemon Juice 4 cups fresh blueberries, at room

temperature



#### Directions:

- Preheat the oven to 375 degrees F. Butter a 9x13 inch baking dish (or line with a parchment paper instead to remove)
- In a large mixing bowl whisk together flour, ½ cup granulated sugar, brown sugar, baking powder & salt
- 3. In a small bowl, whisk together the egg and the vanilla until combined
- Add the egg mixture and the cold butter cubes to the flour mixture and using a fork or pastry cutter, cut together until it resembles coarse crumbs.
- Press ½ of the mixture into the bottom and up the sides of prepared baking dish.
- In a separate mixing bowl, whisk together remaining ½ sugar and the corn starch, stir in lemon juice.
- Add the blueberries then toss mixture to evenly coat, pour and spread the coated blueberries evenly over the crust.
- 8. Sprinkle the remaining crumb mixture evenly over the blueberries
- Bake in your preheated oven about 35-40 mins, or until the top is golden brown

Allow to cool for about 20-30 mins before cutting into squares.

Tip: You can use any kind of fruit or pie filling with this recipe.






