DIRECTOR'S MESSAGE

The Thanksgiving Holiday is just around the corner, and NSC has many blessings to report. First, our Fall Fundraiser was a success. I can't say I wasn't worried! We had only sold 44 tickets 4 days before the event. We had over 30 people purchase tickets at the door on the evening of the event. It was a challenge for the kitchen, but we powered through and received rave reviews. The net income from our Fall Fundraiser is \$22,985! An increase of over \$4,000 from the previous year! Many Kenai Peninsula Businesses supported our event, knowing that funds go towards the Nikiski Senior Center: Thelma McConnell Scholarship program and funding for our senior services, such as expanding senior housing.

Another blessing we received was the Kenai Peninsula Family Caregiver Support Program Grant (KPFCSP). The grant is a three year grant awarded through the State of Alaska. We will provide more information about the new service program as it is developed. In short, we can provide Respite/Chore/Personal Care Service hours to seniors 60 and older, among many other resources. NSC will hire additional employees to support this program, and we will serve the entire Kenai Peninsula.

We have many fun activities and presentations during the months of November and December. Watch our Facebook page or join us for lunch to hear announcements about current events.

Strawberry

- 1 (15.25 oz) box white cake mix, plus ingredients called for on box of 1 (3 oz) box strawberry jell-o
- Frosting
- · 1.5 cups heavy cream
- 1 (8 oz) block cream cheese, room temperature 2/3 cup confections sugar
- 1 tsp pure vanilla extract
- 1/8 tsp kosher salt
- Topping
- 24 vanilla sandwich cookies, such as Golden Oreos
- 4 Tbsp (1/2 stick) unsalted butter, melted
- 1 (3 oz) box Strawberry Jell-o



Directions:

- CAKE
 - 1. Preheat oven to 350. Grease a 13" x 9" baking pan with cooking spray. Prepare cake according to package directions.
 - 2. Pour batter into prepared pan. Bake cake until a tester inserted into the center comes out clean, 20 to 25 minutes. Let cool.
 - 3. Using a bamboo skewer or chopstick, poke holes all over cake, making sure not to go through the bottom and spacing 1/2" to 1" apart.
 - 4. In a small saucepan, bring 1/2 cup water to a boil. Add Jell-o powder; whisk until dissolved. Remove from heat and whisk in 1/2 cup cold water. Pour gelatin mixture evenly over holes on cake. Cover and refrigerate at least 2 hours or up to overnight.
 - FROSTING
 - 1. In a large bowl, using a handheld mixer, beat cream on medium-high speed until stiff peaks form.
 - 2. In another large bowl, using a handheld mixer, beat cream cheese on medium-high speed until smooth and fluffy. Add confections sugar and beat until smooth, then add vanilla and salt. Fold in whipped cream until just combined.
 - 3. Spread frosting over top of cake; reserve remaining frosting for topping (optional). TOPPING
 - 1. In a food processor, pulse cookies to pea-sized crumbs. Transfer to a medium bowl. Pour butter over crumbs, sprinkle with Jell-o powder, and stir to combine.
 - 2. Sprinkle crumb mixture over frosting, then lightly press down on crumbs to adhere.


