Our Valentine's Dinner was a huge success. Some comments we heard were "Best steak ever. Awesome entertainment. What a great price. Dessert was delectable"".





Ingredients:

- 2 (7 ounce) cans chopped mushroom undrained
- 2 cups water
- 2 tablespoons butter
- 1 small onion, chopped
- 1/4 cup all-purpose flour
- 1 teaspoon seasoning salt
- 1 (12 ounce) can evaporated milk

Directions:

- 1. Drain mushroom liquid into a measuring cup and add water to make 2 cups.
- Melt butter in a large saucepan over medium heat, add onion and cook until softened; remove from heat.
- 3. Stir in flour and seasoning salt.
- 4. Slowly add the mushroom liquid mixture and milk, stirring to prevent lumps; return to heat.
- Add mushrooms and cook until mixture comes to a boil. ~ Enjoy

2. When you throw babies in the air, they laugh because they know you will catch them. That is trust.


3. Every night we go to bed without any assurance of being alive the next morning, but still we set alarms to wake up. That is hope.


